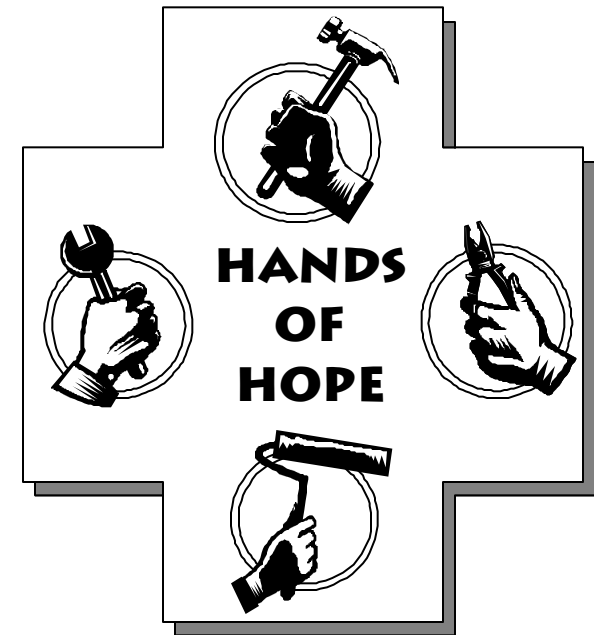

What the Recipient Needs to Provide:

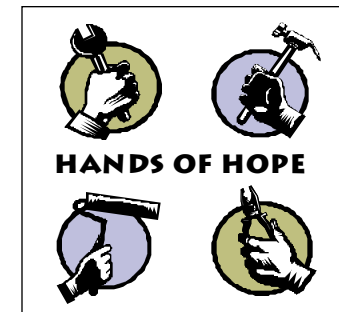
